

Baby Camo Knitted Hat By: Eclectic Knit Knacks



Materials:	
US #4 Circular needles 16 inches	Tapestry needle
1 stitch marker	(Optional) four US #4 DPN
1 skein MC yarn (used camo)	(Optional) pompom in MC and/or CC
1 skein CC yarn (used orange)	
Abbreviations:	
K - knit	P - purl
CO - cast on	BO - bind off
SST(S) - stitch(es)	SM - slip stitch marker
K2TOG - knit 2 stitches together	P2TOG - purl 2 stitches together
MC - main color	* - repeat
DPN - double pointed needles	CC - contrasting color

Fits Ages: 3 - 6 months Circumference: 14 inches - 17 inches

Instructions: CO #80 STTS in CC Place stitch marker after 80th SST and join in the round

Ribbing (CC): Rounds 1-5: * K2, P2 * SM

BOdy: repeat rounds 1-4 until entire piece is 4 inches in length Round 1: * K1, P1 * SM Round 2: * K1, P1 * SM Round 3: * P1, K1 * SM Round 4: * P1, K1 * SM Before moving to Top section, finish the body section ending with rounds 3 & 4. Top: Switch to DNP if needed Round 1: * P2TOG, K1 * SM 53 SSTS Round 2: * P1, K1 * SM Round 3: * K2TOG, P1 * SM 35 SSTS Round 4: * K1, P1 * SM Round 5: * P2TOG, K1 * SM 23 SSTS Round 6: * P1, K1 * SM Round 7: * K2TOG, P1 * SM 15 SSTS Round 8: * K1, P1 * SM Round 9: * P2TOG, K1 * SM 10 SSTS Round 10: * P1, K1 * SM Cut long tail about 7 inches & thread through tapestry needle. B0 by slipping all SSTS knit like onto tapestry needle, remove SM, synch top of hat closed & sew in all loose ends.

Embellishments: Sew on a pompom in the main and/or contrasting color to the top of the hat.

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
